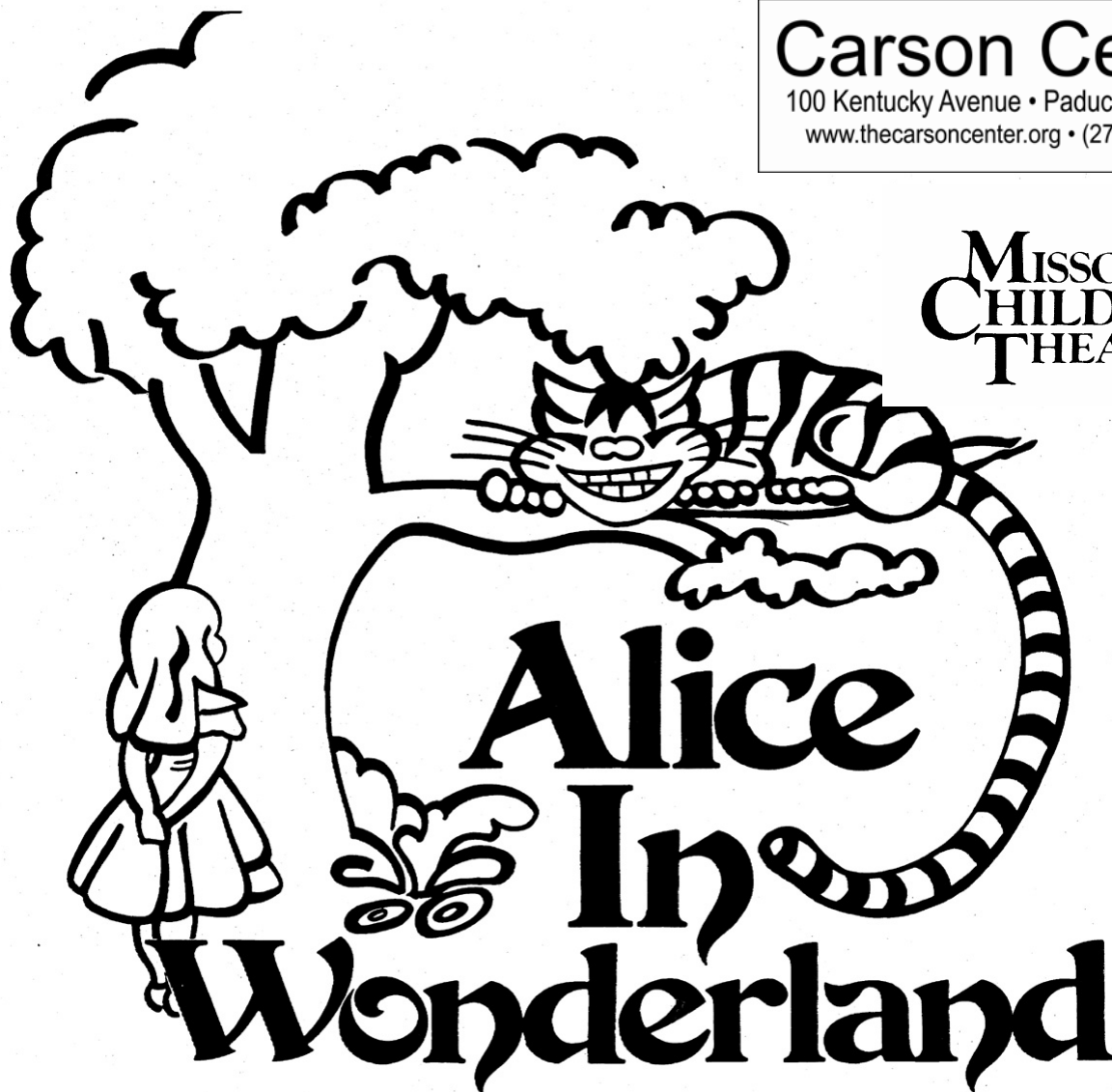

ABOUT THE AUDITION

Join us at the Carson Center for an opportunity to audition for an exciting, musical production of *Alice in Wonderland*. If cast, you will spend a week with professional actors from Missoula Children's Theater while you rehearse and star in two 1-hour performances on the Carson Center stage!!

AUDITION LOCATION AND TIME

Students and their parent/guardian are asked to arrive at the Carson Center 30 minutes early (9:00 a.m. 7/6/2009) to complete permission slips and audition forms. This is a group audition—no advance preparation is necessary, but a smile ☺ never hurts! Students should just be ready to come and have a great time! Students will be required to stay the entire 2 hours of the audition. Due to time constraints, anyone missing the initial audition will not be considered in the casting of the show. **PLEASE NOTE: There is NO guarantee that everyone who auditions will be cast. If cast, each student will be responsible for a \$25 materials fee. There is no charge to audition.**

AGES OF THOSE AUDITIONING

All Missoula Children's Theater Tour shows are designed for students entering 1st grade through 12th grade. There are roles especially suited for all ages, skill levels and experience levels. Approximately 50-60 student actors will be cast in the show. Those who are not cast are invited to participate in the free theater classes offered during the week.

ASSISTANT DIRECTORS

During the audition, four to six Assistant Directors (ADs), ages ten and older, are selected to help teach and direct the show early in the week as well as take on technical responsibilities at performance time. Their logistical help and creative ideas are a vital part of our process and the experience of the Asst. Directors can be just as valuable as that of any cast member. They are normally older students who do take part in the audition session. It is a common misconception that junior high and high school students can only be involved in an Assistant Director capacity. Please note that there are roles in the show designed for older students as well.

The Missoula Children's Theatre is a non-profit organization based in Missoula, Montana. This coming year more than 65,000 cast members across the globe will take to the stage to the delight and applause of their families, friends, community, neighbors and teachers!
